STABLING: Stabling will be available on the grounds. Please indicate if stabling is required at time of entry.

RIBBONS and PRIZES: Championship rugs for all EA and FEI champions. Prize money in all EA and FEI classes, with entries of 10 or more per class. Ribbons awarded in all EA and FEI classes, 1st to 6th for each competition.

ACTDA Competition Conditions of Entry

- ▶ **To be eligible for entry to official tests you and your horse must be a current member of EA.**
- ▶ This competition will be conducted under EA rules except where FEI rules and/or special conditions apply.
- ▶ As per FEI & EA Rules **ACTDA reminds riders that the welfare of the horse is paramount.** In accordance with FEI & EA guidelines & rules a warm up area steward will be located at each warm up area throughout the competition.
- ▶ Entry Fees must accompany entries and **no late entries** will be accepted. Any late entries will be placed on a reserve list for each competition.
- ▶ **Refund of entries after the closing date for entries.** The club will refund 50% of entry fees when presented with a veterinary certificate within 48 hours or scratching.
- ▶ Horses are limited to compete at two consecutive levels for EA tests. FEI horses are limited to two consecutive levels. Each horse is limited to one rider.
- ▶ All competitors are required to wear an **AS/NZS 3838 1998** or **EN 1384** or **ASTN F1 163** helmet at all times when mounted. Failure to comply with this ruling will result in elimination. Competition attire including formal headgear is permitted in the final warm up arena and test if over 18 years of age.
- ▶ Only horses entered are permitted on the grounds during the event. Reserve listed horses/riders may also attend on the day/s entered.
- ▶ **HC and Young Rider** must declare when entering their intentions to ride.
- ▶ Young Riders are up to and including the year in which they turn 21 years.
- ▶ **Bridle numbers** must be worn on both sides of the horse, and be shown at all times during warm up and competition. Please nominate your bridle number on the entry form. **If you do not have a Bridle number please obtain one from EA prior to entry. 02 9620 2660**
- ▶ Over subscription - Entries will be accepted in order of receipt with Global Entries entrants taking precedence. A reserve list will be maintained. Should a competitor not receive a ride, entry fees will be reimbursed.
- ▶ Gear Check prior to entering the warm-up arenas is compulsory. Failure to present for gear check will result in elimination.
- ▶ **NO lunging on warm up and main arena**
- ▶ **Callers NOT permitted**
- ▶ **NO leading horses in halters on the main arena or near warm up areas.**
- ▶ **Official Pony** must have EA Dressage Performance Card marked PONY and not exceed 149 cm with shoes and 148 cm without shoes.
- ▶ ACTDA member tests are eligible for ACTDA point score.
- ▶ **Limited yards and stables are available at Equestrian Park. Stable bookings are requested at time of entry, yard bookings are not possible and will be on a first come first basis.**
- ▶ **Performance Cards** must be available on the day of the competition
- ▶ **Ribbons** awarded to 3rd place for up to 5 horses and events with 6 horses, up to 6th place
- ▶ **Not permitted in the competition area** dogs, children and prams
- ▶ **All dogs to remain on leash within the competition venue**
- ▶ Video and photographic equipment must be kept at least 10 metres from the arena

Spectators and visitors are welcome at all times
